



Elvis Still Draws A Crowd.

As the Elvis Presley legend continues to grow, so does the American public's interest in Elvis programming."The King's" popularity is greater than ever, as witnessed by the ratings:

- ► Elvis and Me, an ABC network special, averaged a 24.5 rating over two nights in February of 1988.
- ► The Elvis Files, a syndicated primetime special from LBS delivered a 8.2 national rating in August of 1991.
- Raycom's Elvis' Graceland, a one-hour syndicated special, hosted by Priscilla Presley, cleared 93% of the U.S., with a 7.2 national rating.

20th Anniversary Countdown.

Raycom and Elvis Presley Enterprises have entered into a five year agreement to produce an annual special during Tribute Week (August 9-August 16). The first program, America Comes To Graceland, will air in August 1993, in tandem with the two-hour biography, Elvis: His Life and Times.

In 1994, 1995 and 1996, Raycom will distribute a new "America Comes to Graceland," originating from the Presley Estate in the same one-hour format.

In 1997, on the 20th Anniversary of Elvis Presley's death, Raycom will produce a three-hour special from Graceland incorporating the Elvis: His Life and Times video biography into what promises to be an unprecedented worldwide memorial tribute.
