Brian Flajole, who joined Raycom Sports in 1991, assumed the duties of Vice President, Golf Operations in November, 1997. He is responsible for all day to day operation of Raycom Sports' golf ventures including three LPGA golf tournaments -- the Longs Drugs Challenge in Lincoln, CA, the Electrolux USA Championship in Nashville, TN and the AFLAC Champions played on the Robert Trent Jones Golf Trail in Alabama. He also managed Raycom's involvement in the 2000 US Track and Field Olympic Trials, which set new records for attendance and sponsorship revenue. Flajole began his career at Raycom Sports working on the Blockbuster Bowl staff from the Fort Lauderdale office. Flajole assumed the title of Executive Director in 1992, and was responsible for managing all aspects of the \$3 million annual Bowl Game. Prior to joining Raycom, Flajole spent two years at the University of Washington as the assistant to the Director of Intercollegiate Athletics. There his responsibilities included overseeing departmental business affairs, negotiating cable television rights and coordinating football travel.
