And America will be watching! The Glasnost Bowl is a football game and a whole lot more. It's the first American football game ever played in the Soviet Union.

It's the opening game of the season for both Southern Cal and Illinois, and both teams have high hopes for the 1989 season. USC has won the Pac-10 title the last two seasons, and will be the favorite to make it three in a row. Illinois is considered a rising star in the Big Ten, and made a bowl appearance in its first season under coach John Mackovic last year.

The game will be played in 50,000-seat Dynamo Stadium in Moscow. It's a global television event carried live on ABC in the United States and on Channel One in the Soviet Union.

A Historic Event

The Glasnost Bowl is the first American football game to be played in the Soviet Union. On September 2, 1989, the University of Southern California and the University of Illinois will kick off their regular seasons, and make college football history, before a crowd of 50,000 fans at Dynamo Stadium in Moscow. Also watching will be a global television audience, including United States fans tuned in to ABC Sports.



The University of Southern California

USC begins its second century of collegiate competition in 1989 with a reputation as one of the game's most successful programs. The Trojans have earned Rose Bowl invitations in each of Larry Smith's first two years as head coach, and the 1989 edition hopes to add to that string. USC has played in the Rose an unprecedented 26 times, produced four Heisman Trophy winners and more than 100 first-team All-Americans.

"All of us at USC are excited about being invited to play in the Glasnost Bowl," says Smith. "It will be a great educational and cultural experience for our players and for the Soviet people. USC has been involved in many prestigious sporting events and this will be another historic, groundbreaking event. I think we'll put on a great football game for America, the Soviet Union and the entire world to enjoy."

The University of Illinois

The rich tradition of Illinois football has enjoyed a resurgence during the brief reign of head coach John Mackovic, who took his first team in 1988 to the All-American Bowl. Illinois made history in 1983 by becoming the first team to defeat every other member of the Big Ten in the same season. Legends like Red Grange and Dick Butkus are among the more than 60 All-Americans to have played in Champaign. Illinois has been a pioneer in college football, the birthplace of Homecoming, and breaks new ground again with its appearance in the Glasnost Bowl.

"Illinois has established an enriched tradition in academics and athletics," said Mackovic, who also serves as Illinois' athletic director. "We are proud to participate in a special first event for college football and the history of intercollegiate sport in this country. As a participant in the Glasnost Bowl, it is our hope that Illinois can be an example of what the finest in college athletics is all about."
