Raycom Sports President & CEO RAY WARREN is resigning from his position, citing differences in direction with parent company, Raycom Media. Ray Warren Over the years, Warren took Raycom Sports into property ownership and sales, along with corporate consulting. However, the parent company has recently decided to concentrate more on its core business of owning and managing TV stations. Warren said, "What I like to do isn't something they want to invest in anymore." Still, the two are parting amicably. As evidence, Warren laughed and pointed to the fact that he has access to some of the company's ACC Basketball Tournament tickets through 2011 — the term of Raycom's current rights deal. Warren has been President & CEO since '98, and has been with Raycom Sports since '88, when he left his post as VP/Sales at ABC TV. He will be working as a consultant out of Raycom's N.Y. offices for now. His current contract expires in February.
